### **Entering Mentoring**

On December 9<sup>th</sup>, twenty-three faculty participated in the CIMER Project's "Entering Mentoring" mentor training program (<u>www.cimerproject.org</u>). Organized by NC State's AGEP-NC faculty fellow Reza Ghiladi and facilitated by AGEP-NC PI Yvette Huet and Andrea Dulin from UNC Charlotte, the participants included faculty from NC State's Applied Ecology and Chemistry departments as well as the NC State AGEP-NC Cohort II faculty fellows. The all-day workshop included themes of aligning mentor-mentee expectations, addressing equity and inclusion, cultivating ethical behavior, enhancing work-life integration, maintaining effective communication, and promoting mentee professional development. Using case studies drawn from reallife, the workshop employed an evidence-based, interactive approach designed to help mentors develop skills for engaging in productive, culturally responsive research mentoring relationships.
